# **Conditions of Entry**



This event will run under EA/FEI rules. The Organising Committee (OC) reserves the right to change or amend the program at their discretion. All owners and competitors will be personally responsible for damages to any third parties caused by themselves, their employees, their agents or their horses. Please ensure the safety of your children whilst in proximity to horses.

### **Starts Per Horse**

Horses may only start in a maximum of 2 Classes per day. Horses may only nominate in one title class, children's, junior, young rider, senior. These horses may not start in the Mini Prix. Title horses are permitted to start in height classes and other classes as time permits.

## **Registration and Licenses**

All riders and owners in all classes must be current financial members of EA. All horses MUST hold a current EA base registration. A full registration and jumping licence is required for all classes 105cm and above.

#### **Dress Code**

Riders in all competition rings must be in correct dress unless otherwise instructed by the judge. It is compulsory for athletes to wear a properly fastened helmet at all times whilst mounted. As an exception, senior athletes may remove their helmet at the presentation in the competition arena only.

## Dogs

Dogs must be kept on a leash and under effective control at all times. Dogs are not permitted in warm up or competition areas

#### **Stallions**

The Organising Committee follows the EA stallion code of conduct. Guardians of riders/handlers under 17 years must take responsibility for stallions at all times including when leading, riding or stabling stallions throughout the venue.

## **Presentations and Prize Money**

Presentations will be mounted, and riders must wear their correct attire. Riders who are not available for presentations or who do not fulfill any media commitments that may be required by the OC, may forfeit all prize money. Winners of classes may be required to participate in photo and media obligations. Prize money in all classes will be Direct Debited within 14 days of the event. All other classes will be given prize money at event.



## **Swabbing**

1. **Medication Control**: This event will be run under current FEI Equine Anti-Doping and Controlled Medication Regulations (2010 and amendments) and the Equestrian Australia National Medication Control Policy. www.equestrian.org.au/medication-control. ## Event Cancellation due to circumstances outside of organiser's control

# Conditions for Children, Junior, Young Rider and Senior

A rider may not ride more than three horses (if entries permit) in any one championship division but in the case of excessive entries, the OC reserve the right to restrict a rider to two starts.

All Children, Junior, Young Rider and Senior entries will qualify for the FINAL.

Competitors whose age allows them to compete in different divisions may do so but only if on different horses.

**Children**: An Athlete may compete in Children's classes until the end of the calendar year in which they turn 14 years old.

**Juniors:** An Athlete may compete in Junior classes from the commencement of the year of their 12th birthday until the end of the year of their 18th birthday. Athletes may take part in open Competitions 120cm and above from the beginning of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 12 years.

**Young Rider:** An Athlete may compete in Young Rider classes from the commencement of the year of their 16th birthday until the end of the year of their 21st birthday.

**Senior Rider:** Athletes are eligible to compete from the beginning of the calendar year in which they turn 18 years.

## Scoring

Points will be awarded for each competitor with the winner receiving 1 more point than the number of competitors in Competition 1. Second will be awarded two less than the winner, third will receive three less than the winner etc. Eliminated, Retired, Disqualified, Withdrawn and Did Not Start combinations do not receive points.

Riders competing in the State Title classes MUST get points over all 3 rounds to be eligible for the overall rankings.

Equestrian Victoria and the Organising Committee reserve the right to change or amend the program at their discretion.



## **Conditions for Mini Prix series**

Mini Prix is a block entry running over 3 days. Points will be awarded in Round 1 and Round 2 as per state championship classes to seed Round 3 (Final).

Mini Prix horses may not start in TItle series i.e. Senior, Young Rider, Junior but may start in stars of the future if eligible.

Starting Height: 130cm first round.

## **Conditions for Amateur series**

Amateur is a block entry running over 3 days. Points will be awarded in Round 1 and Round 2 as per state championship classes to seed Final.

Amateur Rider classes are classes for Athletes who:

- Must not have competed in an Olympic Games or World Equestrian Games in either Jumping or Eventing.
- In the past 10 years must not have competed in a World Cup for Jumping Riders qualifying round or in a 4\* 3 day event.
- Must not have competed in section 1 and 2 at a Royal Show in Sydney, Brisbane, Melbourne, Adelaide or Perth in the past two years.
- Amateur Riders may not compete in an Amateur class on a Horse that will compete in any class where the first round is higher than 1.20m.
- Athletes may compete as amateurs from the beginning of the calendar year in which they turn 21 years of age.

# Conditions for Australian Sports Pony Register (ASPR)

People on Ponies will run as a series along side the Topaz series. Athletes must enter the Topaz series and then nominate for the P.O.P class to be in the running for prizes. The People on Ponies Supplemental is only available to ponies. Height certificates will be checked if ponies are close to height. i.e. 148cms without shoes. All entry fees for the POP supplement goes directly back to POP.

# Conditions for Racing Victoria's Off The Track

Effective from 1 August 2018, any horse bred to race that has been Stud Book-registered, either domestically with the Australian Stud Book or internationally, will be eligible to compete in Off the Track events in Victoria. Racing name and microchip number must be provided with entry. Horses must be claimed on the OTT community website.

The Off The Track (OTT) classes will be incorporated within the open 80cm, 100cm, and 120cm height divisions. To be considered for the OTT Best Performed award, combinations must nominate for Category B within their respective height class at the time of entry.








# **Important Equipe Profile**



### **Stabling and Yards**

Stabling can be booked with entries. Stabling will be charged at \$150 plus a compulsory levy for cleaning of \$35. Stable charges **do not** include bedding. Bedding can be ordered from WPNEC. Stables will be allocated on a first in first serve basis with preference given to those stabling for the entire event. Rather than 1 night. Stabling covers Thursday Night - Saturday Night. Any additional stabling can be booked through WPNEC

Yards will be included in the facility fee. Yards will be on a first in best dressed basis. No booking required. PLEASE NOTE: WPNEC DOES NOT allow build your own yards.

## **Camping and Power**

All campsites offered will be powered. These will be at a one off charge of \$100 for the duration of the event regardless if staying for 1 night or 4.

## **Facility Fee**

Each horse will attract a venue facility fee of \$60 per horse. This is a one off charge for the duration of the event regardless if on grounds for 1 day or 4.

## **Scratching and Refunds**

Scratching's received before close of entries 18th April, or when classes are full, will receive a full refund of entry fees and stabling, less \$50 admin fee and First aid Levy.

Scratching's after the close of entries 18th April, will receive a 50% refund of entry fees less the full \$50 admin fee, on presentation of a medical or veterinary certificate (certificates must be received by 23rd April 2025). After the commencement of competition (8am, 25th April, 2025), there will be no refunds.

## **First Aid Levy**

First Aid Levy of \$20 will be applied to every horse entered. This is non refundable.

#### **Administration Fee**

Each Rider will pay a non refundable Administration Fee of \$50

#### **Arena Fee**

Each rider will pay a \$25 arena fee to allow us to use the amazing surface on the polo fields.

## **Saturday Night Dinner**

Attendees have the option to pre-purchase a meal for \$25, payable with event entry, to secure catering for Saturday night. This meal includes a traditional spit roast, a variety of fresh salads, and a selection of desserts. Pre-booking is essential to ensure availability.

## **WPNEC Conditions**



Werribee Park National Equestrian Centre Committee of Management considers it a privilege that you are allowed to bring your dog to this venue. We insist you always keep your dog under effective control and on a leash.

- 1. Approved Safety Helmets must be always worn when riding.
- 2.Cross Country obstacles must not be jumped/used unless a non-riding level one NCAS coach is present.
- 3. Riding of horses bareback is prohibited.
- 4. Riding of rugged and/or unbridled horses is prohibited.
- 5. Any person may lead a maximum of two horses while mounted.
- 6.Stallions must always be in the control of a person aged eighteen (18) years or over.
- 7. Horses are not permitted within/upon the quadrangle (between the barn & Indoor 1).
- 8. Horses are not permitted near pedestrian doorways.
- 9. Straw bedding is not permitted on the venue. Only wood shavings/sawdust bedding is accepted.
- 10. Helmets must be worn when riding bikes or unpowered scooters.
- 11. Bicycles are not permitted in the indoor arenas or any stable block.
- 12. Bicycles are not permitted near doors designated as public entrances or exits.
- 13. Electric Scooters are not permitted to be used on the venue.
- 14. Speed limits must be always adhered to, the speed limit at WPNEC is 10km p/h.
- 15. Power leads must not be on the ground or over roadways.
- 16. Construction of portable/tape yards is prohibited.
- 17. Alcohol must not be consumed in the Indoor Arenas, unless purchased from the licensed bar located in Indoor Arena No 1.
- 18. Please observe all signs at the venue.
- 19. Horses must be tied in a safe manner. Horses must not be tied to unattached floats, wheelie bins etc.
- 20. No infrastructure to be erected on WPNEC Grounds without written approval by management prior to event.
- 21.Entry and exit doors to Indoors Arenas must not be obstructed at any time.
- 22. Every event to book at WPNEC must provide their own first aid officials.
- 23.Report any incidents, damages, orsafety concerns to WPNEC management immediately.
- 24. Dogs are not permitted on the Cross-Country Course when in use.
- 25. Please call WPNEC Managementshould you require any assistance with ANY Issue.
- 26.Users who do not comply with these guidelines may be refused future use of WPNEC.

These conditions apply unless the Manager or the Committee of Management has given the discipline/event/activity concerned an exemption. \*Exemptions must be applied for in writing and will be only valid for the dates granted. \*


## The screen opens with Add your first horse

Ensure your horse(s)' correct EA number is filled out under "National Federation ID"


