Important Information

Event Cancellation:

Equestrian Victoria or the Organising Committee may cancel the event due to catastrophic conditions, disease, or force majeure, or for any other reason at its absolute discretion. If the event is cancelled, for whatever reason, any refund will be determined at the absolute discretion of Equestrian Victoria, having regard to the direct or fixed costs for the event.

Trade Exhibitor Withdrawal:

Up to 1 April 2026 Trade withdrawals will be refunded less a \$150 administration fee.

From 1 April 2026 there will be no refund of hiring fees as the trade build infrastructure has been loaded for delivery to WPNEC.

All Trade Exhibitors must sign the Inspection Report issued by the Hirer and will therefore be responsible for any damage during the course of the event.

Trading Term & Conditions

Access for Bump-In to Trade Sites will be from 12pm on Thursday 23 April. There is no access after 7.00pm on Thursday evening.

Vehicle access to the Trade area is prior to 7.30am or after 5.00pm on each day of the event. No vehicle access in the Trade Village between these times. There is no parking in the Trade Village area.

All participants must have their own Loss & Public Liability Insurance. Equestrian Victoria Insurance will not cover any loss, damage or liability claim of a participant. Proof of Insurance must be provided to Equestrian Victoria.

Trading Term & Conditions (continued)

The Organising Committee will provide a night watchman on Thursday, Friday and Saturday but are not liable for any damage or missing/stolen goods. Security for Individual Trade Stands will be the responsibility of the Operator.

All electrical equipment (leads, power boards, etc.) must be tested and tagged as per Australian Standards.

To be fair to other exhibitors, and to provide clear access for pedestrians, displays beyond the front line of a Trade Site must not exceed 300mm in depth and/or 1.2m in height.

A Trade Exhibitor who does not book sufficient space for their display will not be permitted to operate without the consent of the Event Coordinator and other Trade Exhibitors affected. No refunds will be issued

The Organising Committee reserves the right to accept and/or reject any or all Trade Stand applications, at its absolute discretion.
